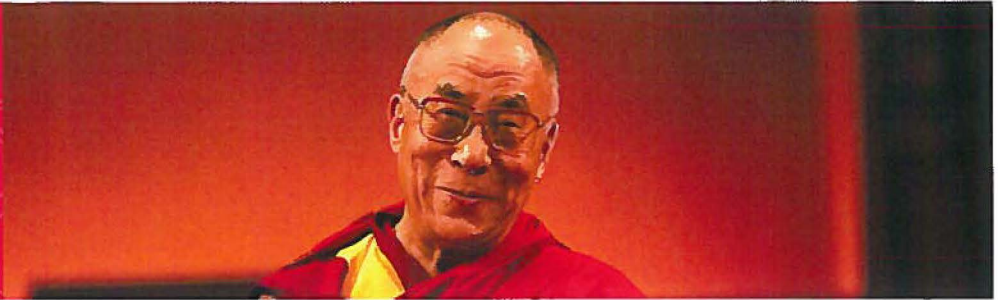


BE THE VILLAGE DALAI LAMA VANCOUVER 2014
